Steward Scholars Program in Anthroposophic Medical Study

Anthroposophic Medicine is a whole-person medical model, practiced by conventionally-trained physicians and nurses who have undergone additional, specialized training to apply a broad array of effective natural medicines. Anthroposophic Medicine incorporates art, music, movement, and massage therapies as elements of collaborative, multidisciplinary health care.

We are pleased to announce the creation of two full-tuition scholarships for eligible integrative medicine fellows to attend the annual training week of the International Postgraduate Medical Training (IPMT), April 27-May 4th 2019 in Chestnut Ridge, NY. The IPMT offers core teachings in Anthroposophic Medicine and is currently offered in more than 14 countries around the world (<https://ipmt.medsektion-goetheanum.org/en/>). This intensive training week includes clinical workshops, foundations of anthroposophic pharmacy, small group medicinal plant study, integrative methodology, morning movement and evening lectures on the inner path of the physician.

Eligibility: The Steward Scholars Program is open to all physicians (MD, DO) currently enrolled in an integrative medicine fellowship. Scholars will be awarded full tuition, including meals, plus \$500 stipend towards travel or lodging costs. Lodging must be arranged separately and is not included in tuition. After the course, recipients are asked to submit a short discussion of how Anthroposophic Medicine can contribute to academic integrative medicine training. These reports must be received by July 1, 2019.
